








































## Hello!



Mathues Veloso De Brito, a second-degree black belt under Walter "Cascão" Vital, is no stranger to hard work and a lifetime commitment to martial arts. A native of Brazil, coach Matt started Judo at the age of 4 under the tutelage of legendary Sensei Lhofei Shiozawa, who was the first Brazilian Olympic Judoka in 1964. From there Matt started Jiu jitsu at the age of 6 and after years of competing in both Judo and Jiu jitsu has won multiple national and world titles. Matt's gentle yet firm teaching style allows him to connect with his students in a way that helps them become successful and highly competitive.

Nolan's journey started at the age of 7. From the first class you could see the sparkle in his eyes and his thirst for competition. His competitive nature came out and he begged to go to a BJJ competition after his first full week in class. Even

though he didn't compete then, he made it to the next competition and never looked back. Competition brought out a different side of Nolan. His enthusiasm and commitment to the sport had him moving through the ranks and earning his grey belt in a mere 5 months.


During this time, Nolan racked up multiple gold medals and trophies. At one of these

competitions, Modern Flow, Nolan won all 3 of his matches by arm bar submissions; the fastest being in 22 seconds and making this his signature move, the "GhostRyder." In just over a year, Nolan's dedication to the sport earned him a yellow belt. Nolan's commitment to the craft has garnished him many accomplishments. He finished #1 in the Elite Federation of Grapplers, #1 in the state of Michigan and #4 overall in the

country in the Fuji BJJ series for youth intermediate Gi.

During his time in Jiu jitsu, Nolan has been aided by many individuals that sponsored him to compete nationally. Nolan finished with a Bronze in his first international competition in November 2021 at the IBJJF Jiu jitsu Con kids that saw over 900 competitors and was the second largest kids'






competition of the year. In 2022 Nolan would like to build on that and compete in more international competitions and become a brand ambassador for Fuji sports.
